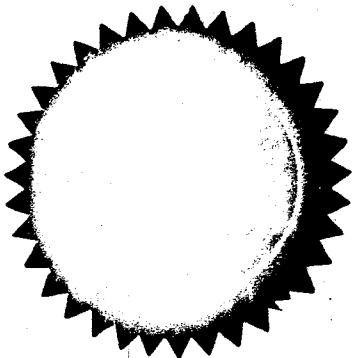
Greeting.
