David M. McIver, 39, of 305 Faneuil st., Brighton, a printing instructor at Roxbury Memorial High School for Boys, was fatally stricken yesterday while teaching class. He would have been 40 today.

Born in Boston, he was a graduate of Roxbury Memorial High School for Boys. He was an Army veteran of World War II and after the war took a state teacher training course at Brandeis University.

Mr. McIver had been a teacher at Roxbury Memorial for three years and also taught nights at Boston Trade School.

He was a member of Our Lady of Presentation High School and a social member of the Brighton Council, Knights of Columbus.

He leaves a wife, Rufine E. (Power); a son, David M.
