

Dr. John McIver, ophthalmologist

A funeral Mass will be said tomorrow at 10 a.m. in Our Lady of Good Counsel Church, Quincy, for Dr. John M. McIver, 67, former chief of ophthalmology at Quincy City Hospital. He died unexpectedly Tuesday at his home on Narragansett road, Quincy.

Dr. McIver was born in Quincy. He was graduated from Boston College in 1935 and Boston University School of Medicine in 1939. He served his residency at University Hospital, Western Reserve University, Cleveland.

He served as a major with the Army Medical Corps in World War II from 1942 to 1946 as a major. He maintained offices on Southern Artery, Quincy, and was on the staff of University Hospital in Boston.

He leaves his wife, E. Eileen (Maher); two sons, Christopher M. and John K. McIver, both of Quincy; a daughter, Nancy Lee Schafer of Osterville; four brothers, James of Brockton, Gerald of Woburn, Fred of Dorchester, and Charles McIver of Springfield, Mo.; three sisters, Loretta McCarthy of Worcester, Patricia Kronk of Dorchester and Eileen Favreau of Minneapolis, and four grandchildren.
