

## Road Deaths In State Hit Record 168

Four persons died in traffic
accidents in New Hampshire
during the weekend — including
three in one accident — raising
the state's fatality toll for the
year, already a record, to 168.

Killed in a two-car crash on Route 101 in Auburn Saturday were Miss Bertha McKenna, 71, and her sister Miss Pauline McKenna, 58, both of Manchester, and Philip Bouchard, 28, of Rochester.

Nine-year-old Michael Anderson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Donald Mahoney of Manchester, died of injuries sustained Sunday when he was struck by a car as he ran across the Everett Turnpike in Manchester. Mahoney was the child's stepfather, State Police said. The driver of the car said the child jumped a dividing fence on the median strip of the expressway and into the path of the vehicle.
