Four Persons Killed On Weekend in N.

Nine-year-old Michael Anderson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Don-ald Mahoney of Manchester, ald died of injuries sustained Sunday when he was struck by a car as he ran across the Everett Turnpike in Manchester. Mahoney was the child's stepfather, State Police said. The driver of the car said the child jumped a dividing fence on the median strip of the expressway and into the path of the vehicle.
