

Carol Smith Snow

Funeral services will be held at the Napa Chapel of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints at 2 p.m. tomorrow for Mrs. Carol Smith Snow, 20, who was killed in an Oakland area traffic accident Friday.

Bishop Clair B. Black of the Napa Second Ward will officiate. Interment will be at Tulocay Cemetery. Services are under the direction of Oak Park Hills Chapel of Walnut Creek.

Mrs. Snow, a former Napa resident, had been married just two months to Lawrence V. Snow II, 20, who is in critical condition at a Walnut Creek hospital from injuries received in the accident.

Mrs. Snow attended Napa schools when her father, Jay E. Smith, managed a local grocery store. Her parents now live in Walnut Creek. She graduated from Napa High in 1962.

Surviving besides her husband and parents are a brother, Robert Smith of Walnut Creek and grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. V. H. Tuft of Oakland.

Mrs. Snow and her husband both were students at Brigham Young University in Provo, Utah.
