Shriner and Elk representative Jack Forster receives a giant hug from Ralph Popp as reward for giving him some pointers on the game of softball.



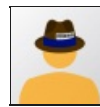
Mixed emotions register on the faces of Kathy Shuart and Rodney Jacques as they watch some of their friends from the hospital square-off during some softball action.
