

Woman's skeletal remains found

RAMARA, Ont. (CP) — Skeletal remains found last week in a field southeast of Orillia, Ont., have been identified as those of a woman reported missing in January.

For nearly 60 days, friends of Patty-Jo Kelly had searched local fields on foot and in small aircraft. Kelly's remains were spotted last Thursday from a police helicopter near the restaurant where she worked and about two kilometres from the spot where her abandoned van was found 57 days earlier.

The death of the 38-year-old Gamebridge resident is still a suspicious one, police said. Only the results of forensic testing will tell the cause of death, Const. Rosemary Raycraft of Orillia provincial police said.
