

Memorial Set For Air Force Pilot

WEST HARTFORD — A memorial service with military honors will be held Tuesday morning at St. Mark the Evangelist Church for Lt. Col. William E. Morel III, the Air Force pilot killed during a jet-fighter training mission in Oregon.

Morel, a 1974 graduate of Conard High School, died Oct. 21 when the F-15E he and his copilot were flying crashed during an evening training flight over southeast Oregon.

Morel, 42, who enlisted in the Air

Force after high school, was acting commander for the 366th Operations Support Squadron attached to the 391st Bold Tigers F-15E Fighter Squadron at the Mountain Home Air Force Base in Idaho.

Morel's younger brother, Eric Morel, lives in West Hartford, and his sister, Theresa Hrynkiw, lives in Coventry.

The service will begin at 10 a.m. The church is at 467 S. Quaker Lane.
