

Holbrook family mourns teen killed in New Hampshire crash

Posted May 11, 2016 at 12:51 PM Updated May 11, 2016 at 7:46 PM HOLBROOK – A local family is mourning the loss of a 19-year-old Holbrook teenager killed in a horrific accident in New Hampshire on Mother's Day.

Christopher Nugent Jr. was killed in the rollover accident in Windham, New Hampshire early Sunday morning. Two unidentified 17-year-old passengers, a male and a female, were also seriously injured in the accident, authorities said. Their conditions were not known Wednesday morning.

Nugent, one of five children, was a 2015 graduate of Blue Hills Regional Technical School in Canton, according to his obituary. His family declined comment Wednesday.

The crash happened just after midnight Sunday near Exit 3 on I-93 in Windham, New Hampshire. Investigators and witnesses said the driver, Nugent, lost control and struck the guardrail, causing the vehicle to split in two. Debris could be found 80 yards away. He was pronounced dead at Parkland Medical Center in New Hampshire.

The crash remains under investigation and anyone with information is urged to call New Hampshire State Police at 603-223-8836.

A funeral Mass is planned for 11 a.m. Friday at St. Joseph's Church in Holbrook.

Condolences from family and friends poured out on social media this week after news of his sudden death.

"I am so sorry Chris, u are all in my prayers," wrote Tina Brown.
