E. P. Boy, Four Others Killed In Highway Crash

A four-year-old El Paso boy was killed yesterday and his parents and three-year-old sister seriously injured in a head-on collision near Haskell during a heavy rain.

Thomas Roy Paulhamus, son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard E. Paulhamus of 3708 Flery avenue, was killed instantly.

Sheriff's Officer Tom Holland of Haskell described the accident scene as "a terrible sight."

The accident occurred during a heavy rainstorm in flat country near the northeast Texas town.

Mr. and Mrs. Paulhamus and their daughter, Karen Sue, are in serious condition at Haskell County Hospital.

He said the accident report filed by State Highway Patrolmen indicated that Paulhamus was across the center-stripe of the highway when his car and one driven by Donald Wilson of Vernon collided.

In the Wilson car were Wilson, 22, his wife, 22, their two-year-old daughter, Debra Ann and their six-month-old son, Mike. The entire family was killed.

Paulhamus was listed as a civilian employe at Ft. Bliss on the accident report, Holland said.

His nearest relative was listed as his parents of Williamsport, Pa.
